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Course Description:

During this semester-long course, students will:

1. *Learn to sing proficiently alone and with others.*
2. *Work in unity to produce a cohesive choral sound.*
3. *Learn to read and notate music given in class.*
4. *Will listen to, annotate and describe music using proper terminology.*

Grading and Assignments:
